RULES - CLASSIFICATION

Current NRA Metallic Silhouette Rifle Rules will apply. Unclassified competitors will compete in the highest available class. Classification books or Cards must be presented when registering at the Range.

COMPETITION - ELIGIBILITY

Canadian residents **MUST HAVE A CURRENT PROVINCIAL MEMBERSHIP**. Non-residents must be members of their respective national bodies. I.e.: U.S. residents must have proof of NRA membership. Competitors must present copies of their membership cards when submitting entry. BCTSA memberships are available online.

SPECIAL SQUADDING REQUESTS

Requests for special squadding of competitors sharing equipment or coaching will be accommodated in-so-far as possible on a first come, first serve basis, provided such requests are made IN WRITING, and entries for ALL competitors involved are included with the request.

CERTIFICATION OF FIREARMS

All rifles must be certified prior to their use in the tournament.

Rifle certification for all rifles on May 17th after 12 PM. Please certify High Power rifles before the Small-bore match. Equipment & apparel may be inspected at random by Match Officials during the matches.

TIE BREAKING

Following the completion of each days matches, ties will be broken using a single shot knockout format with the exception of Provincial Champion which will be broken using a five shot string, fired on Turkeys.

PROTESTS

There will be a \$40 fee for any protest brought to the jury. If the jury deems the protest to be valid \$40 will be refunded to the protester otherwise it will go into the target setters donations fund.

SMALL-BORE MATCH SCHEDULE

Competitors will score for the shooter **immediately following them on the line**. The last relay will score for the first relay. Presentation of awards will follow the completion of the matches.

May 17th	Range open for practice – <u>SMALL-BORE ONLY</u> ~ Competitors are to set their own targets and police the range. Clubhouse will be open for picking up of registration kits. <i>Watch bulletin boards for official notices.</i>
May 18	8:30am - Opening ceremonies 9:00am - 40 shot Standard Rifle match, 15min break followed by 40 shot Hunting Rifle match. Lunch break, 40 shot Standard Rifle. Shoot-offs at the end of day. Awards and door prizes handed out during dinner. Provided Steak dinner!!!
May 19th	9:00am -40 shot Hunter Rifle match, 15min break 40 shot Standard Rifle match. Lunch break, 40 shot Hunter Rifle match. Shoot-offs followed up with Aggregate shoot-offs.

HIGH POWER MATCH SCHEDULE

May 20th	9:00am - 40 shot Standard Rifle match, Lunch followed by 40 shot Hunting Rifle match Shoot-offs at end of day Daily Match Awards
May 21st	9:00am -40 shot Standard Rifle match followed by 40 shot Hunting Rifle match Shoot-offs at end of day. Daily and Aggregate soon after.

SMALL-BORE AND HIGH POWER AWARDS SCHEDULE

Presentation of match awards will follow the completion of the day's matches. Aggregate awards will be presented following the presentation of the match awards on the final day of each competition.
Under three shooters per class, shooters will be moved up to the next higher class, or compete for Match Winner Award (rule 19.8)

MATCH AWARDS & AGGREGATE AWARDS

***1ST** place and Match Winner will be awarded per class in each of the daily matches

***1ST, 2ND, & 3RD** placings will be awarded per class in the Aggregate standings

BC PROVINCIALS RIFLE SILHOUETTE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

Small-bore & High Power Rifle Silhouette Championships will be the aggregate of the three matches for each class,

240 Shot BC Provincial Resident Smallbore Champion
160 Shot BC Provincial Resident Highpower Champion
BC Provincials Open Smallbore/Highpower Champion
Provincial Smallbore/Highpower Daily Champions per class
Provincial Smallbore/Highpower Lady Champion
Provincial Smallbore/Highpower Senior Champion
Provincial Smallbore/Highpower Junior Champion

PIN AWARDS

Small-bore: 10 in-a-row pins will be awarded to all classes, 5 in-a-row pins only to “B”, “A”, “AA”

High Power: 5 and 10 in-a-row pins will be awarded to all classes

SAFETY

All rules for safety will be strictly enforced. Failure to conform will be a basis for disqualification

1. Rifle actions will be open at all times except on the firing line after the command “READY” is given. At the command “CEASE FIRE” all firearm actions will be opened IMMEDIATELY, Open bolt indicators are MANDATORY.
2. “Dry firing” or aiming firearms behind the firing line is prohibited. Firing line commands must be observed by the users of the designated dry firing area.
3. When not on the firing line firearms will be placed on racks, in cases or other safe places.
4. A shot fired before the “READY” command will result in an automatic disqualification.
5. The Match Director or Range Officer has the authority to ban any competitor, firearm or ammunition at any time for safety reasons.
6. Consumption of any alcoholic beverage, narcotic or controlled substance which can impair the normal mental or physical functions of the body, either on the range or in the spectator or public areas immediately adjacent to the range while the range is in use is prohibited. Disorderly conduct or intoxication is not permitted on the range or any contiguous range property. Violators of this regulation will be subject to immediate disqualification from these Championships with no return of entry fees.

There will be a competitors meeting held on May 18th, 2024 at the Range. The meeting time will be posted at the range.
